Conversation/to make friends:

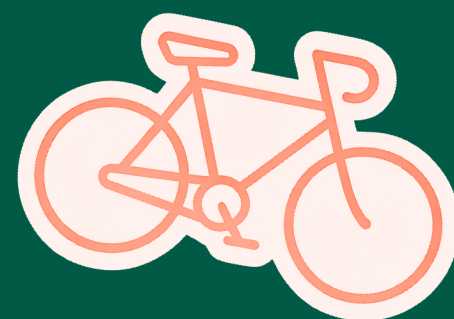
- Hoe heet je? (What's your name?)

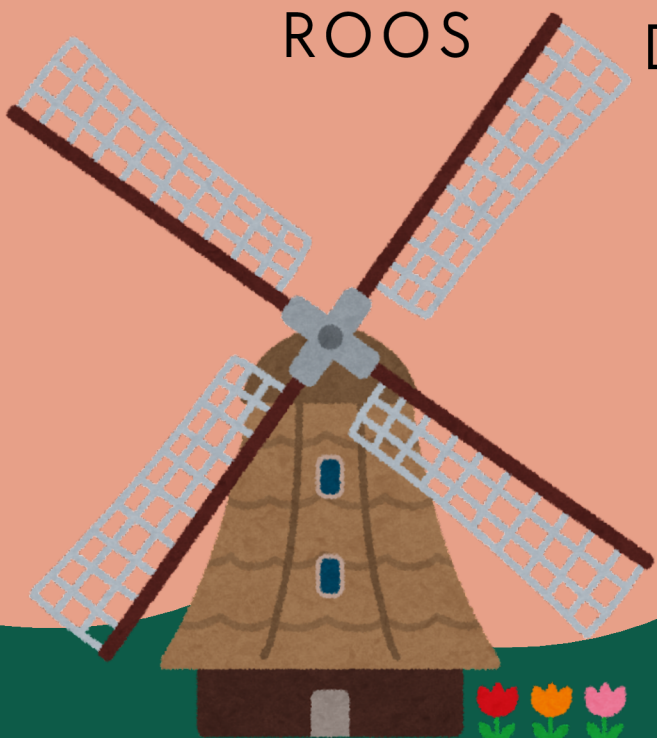
