

NL Scholarship Terms and Conditions

- 1. You must be enrolled at Leiden University during the academic year for which the scholarship is to be awarded. During the stay abroad you will pay the statutory tuition fee to Leiden University.
- 2. You must have permission from the Board of Examiners (Examencommissie) for your period abroad.
- 3. The study, research or internship is a fully recognised part of the diploma and you will receive a minimum of 10 study credits accordingly.
- 4. The study, research or internship should be for a minimum of 7 weeks and a maximum of 12 months.
- 5. The study, research or internship must commence in the period from 1 June (following the application deadline) till 1 June of the following calendar year.
- 6. If you are eligible for funding from the Sustainable Humanities Scholarship (*Duurzame Geesteswetenschappen studie / stage*), Erasmus+ (KA171) International Credit Mobility or have previously received a Holland or NL Scholarship for your period abroad you cannot be awarded the NLScholarship.
- 7. During your studies at Leiden University you will take an active role in activities promoting the NL Scholarship programme.
