### Reverse of the title page

Written fairly formally; max. 800 words.

### Summary

Usually, dissertations include summaries in Dutch and English. For dissertations written in English, at least a Dutch translation of the title and a summary of the contents should be included, and vice versa.

### Curriculum vitae

Include details about your prior education, such as your BA and MA or equivalent, along with the names of relevant institutions. Mention any qualifications associated with the diplomas you earned. Specify the faculty where you carried out your PhD research. Describe the components of the training programme you pursued during your PhD. Additionally, provide information about your professional activities after completing your PhD. Including your year and place of birth is optional.

### Front and back cover

### (Optional) Any other non-scientific additions/expressions (e.g., quotation, motto)

## PROPOSITIONS

### A maximum of 12 propositions in total, of which:

- At least four relate to the specific subject of the dissertation;
- At least four are scientific propositions related to the field of the subject of the dissertation;
- At most four propositions are on one or more subjects of the PhD candidate's choice.
