Leiden University | 8-10 June 2022

How are major world-scale changes in contemporary society governed? How might global matters such as geopolitical shifts, ecological changes, technological innovations, and pandemics be better governed? These questions lie at the heart of the [Global Transformations and Governance Challenges \(GTGC\)](#) programme at Leiden University, launched in 2020.

To showcase the wealth of innovative interdisciplinary cross-faculty research ongoing at Leiden and partner universities concerning governance responses to key global developments, GTGC will hold its **first international conference on 8-10 June 2022 in The Hague**.

Conference proceedings will include high-level roundtables regarding the International Criminal Court (including opening remarks by the ICC President), climate change, and the global Internet in a divided world. Further panels will address questions of global peace and security, global migration, global health, and global human rights. Receptions and lunches will offer additional networking opportunities.
