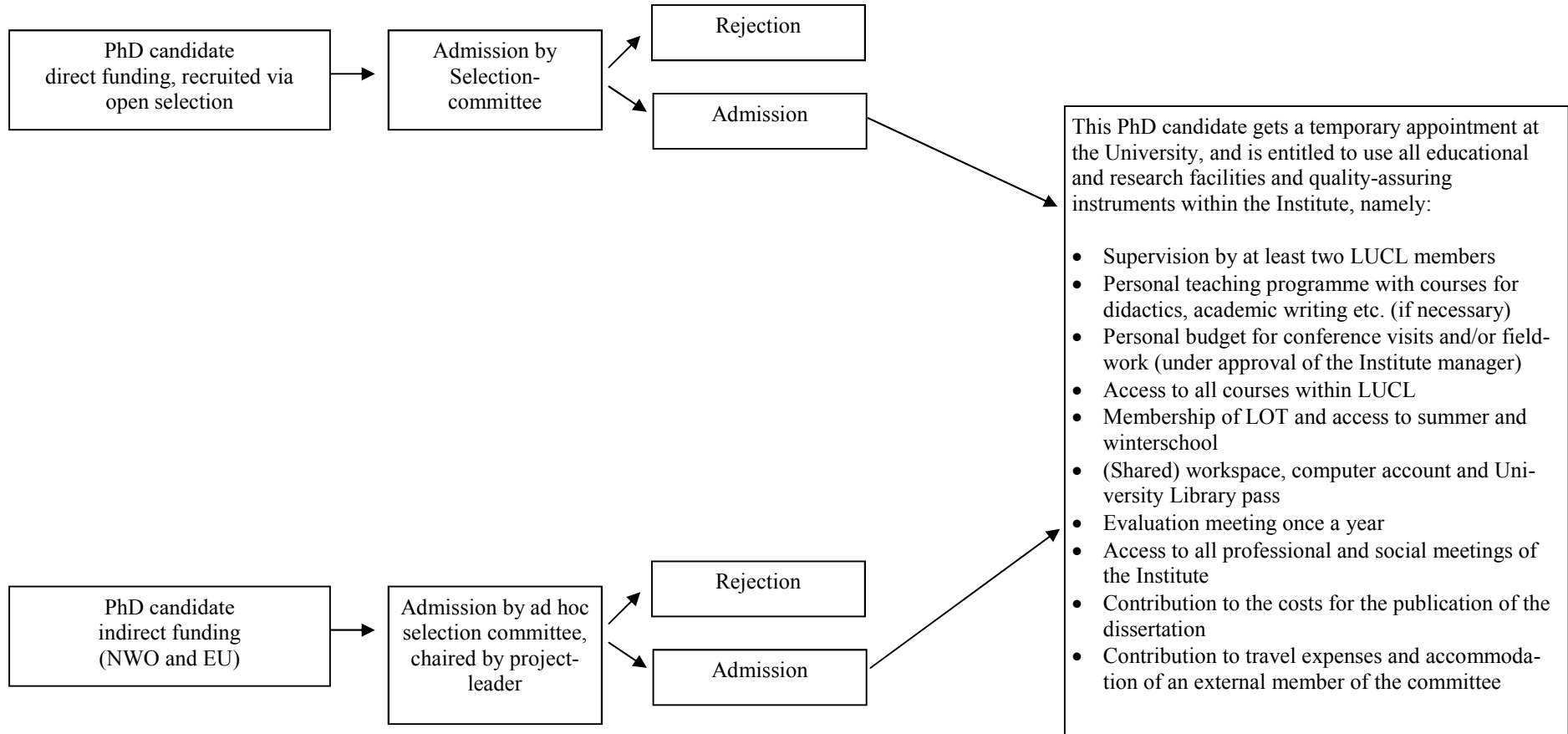
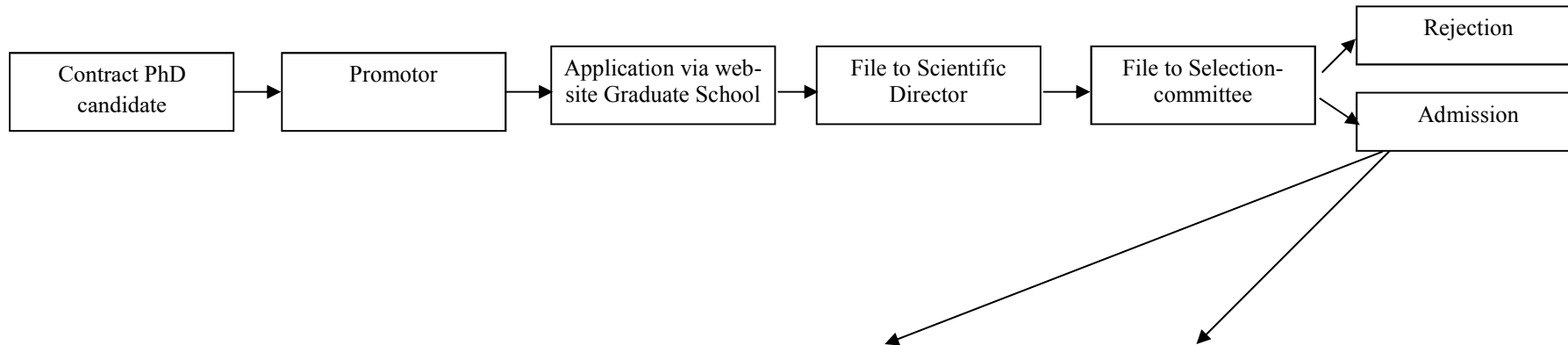


Employed PhD candidate (direct and indirect (NWO en EU) funding)



Contract PhD candidate (subsidised by a grant or self-funded)



Part-time LUCL:

For PhD candidates who want to spend part of their PhD time at LUCL (2x 3 months for instance), the promotor has to present to the LUCL MT an overview of the facilities the PhD candidate wants to use, and the costs that will be involved. The costs will have to be paid by the PhD candidate/him/herself (for each instance, by applying for an external grant) and will not be reimbursed by LUCL. LUCL will contribute to the costs of the publication of the dissertation, and to the travel expenses and accommodation of an external member of the committee.

Before the arrival of an Rj F candidate it has to be clear how his stay will be financed.

Full-time LUCL:

Bench fee € 17.000 (to be paid by the PhD student); waiver to € 4.000 per year minimally.

PhD candidate is entitled to:

- Supervision by at least two LUCL members
- Personal teaching programme with courses for didactics, academic writing etc (if necessary)
- Personal budget for conference visits and/or fieldwork (under approval of the Institute manager)
- Access to all courses within LUCL
- Membership of LOT and access to summer and winterschool
- (Shared) workspace, computer account and University Library pass
- Evaluation meeting once a year
- Access to all professional and social meetings of the Institute
- Contribution to the costs for the publication of the dissertation
- Contribution to the travelling expenses and accommodation of an external member of the committee
