



NISIS Network Day/NOSTER Midyear meeting

Call for applications poster presentations

During the morning session of the network day/midyear meeting, NISIS offers junior researchers the opportunity to give short presentations (five minutes or less) on how they think their research contributes to society, or in other words, how their knowledge and skills can be deployed in academia but certainly also beyond. Besides this presentation, the poster will be on display throughout the day. We invite PhD candidates and research master students, whose research focuses on the study of Muslims, Muslim societies and Islam in the broadest sense of the word, to apply for a poster presentation.

The poster (A3 size) should contain the following information:

- title;
- supervisor(s) involved in research;
- short description of research topic;
- short biography;

PhD candidates and students who want to apply for a poster presentation can send a short biography (including current affiliation) and short abstract of their research (300 words max.) to nisis@hum.leidenuniv.nl. NISIS junior members automatically qualify for participation, but need to register by sending an email to nisis@hum.leidenuniv.nl. The deadline for application is **Monday 22 January 2018**.

The deadline for handing in posters (A3 size, pdf format, by email) is **Tuesday 23 January 2018** at the latest, so that NISIS can take care of printing. Please note that for the presentation a digital version of your poster is required, so bring a one slide PowerPoint to the NISIS Network Day.

NISIS junior members have the opportunity to gain 1 EC for their successful participation in the Network Day. In order to receive 1 EC, participants must give a short presentation, prepare a poster, and show active participation.
