

Berichtigungsliste der griechischen Papyrusurkunden aus Ägypten

BERICHTIGUNGSLISTE I-XII

The ongoing *Berichtigungsliste der griechischen Papyrusurkunden aus Ägypten* (BL) collects all the relevant information from all the available literature needed for the proper understanding of a text for each published documentary papyrus. The thousands of corrections thus gathered are also critically evaluated by checking them against the papyrus (on original or photo) and by putting them in the context of the scholarly history of the text.

The BL is compiled, under the auspices of the International Association of Papyrologists, at the Leiden Papyrological Institute in co-operation with the Institut für Papyrologie at Heidelberg University. For all scholars who study Greek papyrus documents from Egypt - not only papyrologists, but also ancient historians, classicists, legal historians and researchers of early Christianity - the BL remains an indispensable tool.

To date, twelve volumes of the *Berichtigungsliste* have appeared between 1913 and 2009, as well as the *Konkordanz und Supplement zu Berichtigungsliste Band I-VII* (1989), and the *Konkordanz zu Berichtigungsliste Band VIII-XI* (2007).

In the near future all 'Berichtigungen' will be integrated with or linked to the information on each text in the Duke Data Bank of Documentary Papyri, starting with the new corrections in BL XIII and following, and later hopefully also corrections from previous volumes.

BL XIII (2016)

The thirteenth volume of the BL is in the proof-reading stage and will be published as a PDF file in the fall of 2016. It will be made freely available through the websites of the Leiden and Heidelberger Papyrological Institutes, as well as via the PAPY-List.

BL XIV, 1 (2017/2018)

Fortunately, the Leiden Papyrological Institute has received a grant from the Leiden University Institute of Area Studies for an extra half-time BL assistant during the upcoming academic year. This will enable us to publish a first fascicle of BL XIV at the end of 2017 or early 2018, and diminish the gap between the last year of literature included in the BL and the date of publication.

FUTURE HELP NEEDED

To keep up with the published literature we are going to need the help of our colleagues in papyrology. In the coming year we hope to open up a website where volunteers can choose a book or volume of a journal in which to search for corrections. We shall keep you posted!
