

# LUMC Safe on campus education at the LUMC

## Guidelines for students

*Students are welcome at the LUMC for scheduled on campus education activities and reserved study spaces. Health and safety of our patients, students and staff comes first. Below you will find everything you need to know regarding safe on campus education and study spaces.*

### General guidelines



### Non-medical mouth mask mandatory in the LUMC



**In addition to the above hygiene rules, LUMC is obliged to wear its own non-medical nasal mask. For education in the LUMC this means:**

- This obligation applies to everyone: students, teachers, researchers and other staff as well as patients and visitors (13 years or older).
- Bring your own mouth mask.
- The rule of thumb is: wear it when standing or walking. If you sit down, you may take it off.
- On entering and leaving the buildings, and on all movements inside, you wear a mouth mask. So in between lectures, when you visit the toilet and when you go to get coffee.
- You always eat and drink in a seated position.
- If you sit in the lecture room, workgroup/practicum room or reserved study area, you may take off the mouth mask.
- While lecturing, a teacher does not have to wear a mouth mask.
- Some types of education in, for example the dissecting room or labs, are subject to specific rules for students and teachers regarding personal protective equipment. The instructor will inform you about this and provide you with the necessary equipment.

### Please note: do not come to the LUMC if:

- You have any health symptoms that could indicate coronavirus. Stay at home and make an appointment with the GGD for a test: 0800-1202.
- You tested positive for COVID-19 and need to go into quarantine because of that.
- Your housemate has severe corona related symptoms (fever / shortness of breath).
- You need to go into quarantine because you have been in contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19.
- You have recently returned from a country with a red or orange travel advisory in which the Ministry of Foreign Affairs advises a ten-day quarantine. You must not come to the LUMC during these ten days.

## Positive test result?

We urgently advise you to notify your study advisor if your corona test result are positive. The study advisor will ask you about any physical contact you may have had on campus in the last few days before the positive test. This information will be passed on anonymously to the Department of Safety Issues, which in turn will consult the GGD about the need of extra corona measurements.

## Missing out on mandatory education activities?

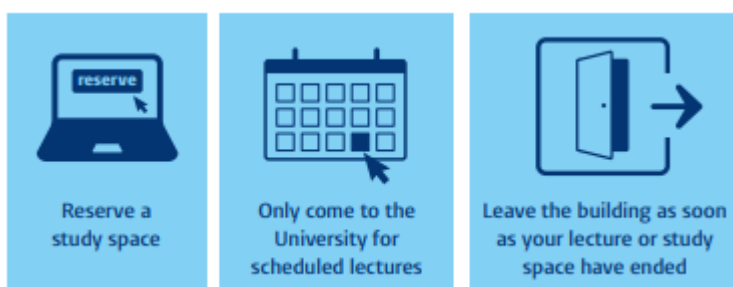
Will you be missing mandatory on campus education activities because of quarantine? Please notify your teacher.

Where possible, the programme will provide the possibility to join the on campus activities online. For certain activities this is not an option (a.o. dissection, practicals). These activities will be either replaced by an alternative assignment or will be postponed to a later date within the academic year.

## (Clinical) Interns

As an intern, you are an employee of the institute that is offering your internship. Follow the measurements that are in place at this institute and notify the Study Advisor of your positive test.

## On campus education and study places



- Need a study space? From **7 September** you can reserve a study space in the Education Building of the Main Building via <https://universiteitleiden.okku.io>. You can reserve a space two days in advance.
- Go directly to the lecture room of study space and leave the building immediately afterwards. Do not linger around in the hallways or other places in the buildings.
- Please clean your own desk before use with the provided materials in the lecture rooms and study spaces.

## Lockers

Want to store your belongings? At the moment **only** the lockers in the foyer of the Education Building are in use for students.

## Lunch

Lunch? Only the HePatho Bar open for students (with a maximum seat capacity) during their regular opening hours.

## Together for safe on campus education

The LUMC can only offer on campus education if everyone is abiding by the guidelines mentioned in this document.

Do you see people ignoring the regulations? Feel free to remind them. Of course this also works the other way around. If you fail to adhere to the regulations, you may be spoken to by our staff. Please respect this.

## Routes

In order to separate the flow of patients, staff and students, we mapped out routes and directions with stickers throughout the buildings. It is important to follow these routes. Take the stairs if possible. The scheme below shows the (new) routes in and out of the LUMC buildings.

Research Building Skills Lab	Via the main entrance of the Research Building <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Use lockers in the Education Building (put on your labcoat)</li></ul>	Via the main entrance of the Research Building
Education Building	Entrance on the side of the Parking Garage.	Exit on the side of the Research Building
