The International and European Governance specialisation of the Master Public Administration provides the essential theoretical background and professional skills to address the challenges of effective and legitimate governance in a globalised world. You learn to formulate governance solutions to address cross-border societal challenges. You will do this by applying state-of-the-art scientific knowledge of the EU and international institutions, international decision-making and management of EU and international organisations. Through the programme you will obtain a deep understanding of the interplay between the international, EU, and (sub)national governance systems and how this interplay affects a national government's capacity to address cross-border societal challenges. The specialisation is designed for you to become a professional capable of developing, implementing and evaluating public solutions for societal problems that transcend national and European borders.

This expertise will prepare you for a job in (inter)national public institutions or private sector organisations that need to cope with implications of an increasingly globalised policy-making environment.
