Course: Extremism, disinformation & Hostile States

Who can apply for this course?

This course is open to mid- and senior-level professionals working in or with the security domain. Typical participants include policymakers, analysts, and practitioners working in law enforcement, intelligence and security services, prosecution, probation services, and counterterrorism.

What is the language of instruction?

The course is taught entirely in English. Participants should have a good command of spoken and written English to fully engage in discussions and group work.

How can I apply?

Applications can be submitted via the online registration form on the programme webpage. Admission is based on professional background and motivation. After submitting your application, you will receive confirmation and practical details from the organisers.

What are the admission requirements?

Applicants should have a relevant professional or academic background in security, governance, or international affairs, and some years of work experience. A university degree (Bachelor's or higher) is recommended, but not mandatory if equivalent experience can be demonstrated.

What is included in the course fee?

The course fee covers tuition, course materials, lunches, and refreshments during the programme. Travel and accommodation are not included.

Where will the course take place?

The course will be held at Leiden University – Campus The Hague (Den Haag). Sessions are most likely scheduled at our location Schouwburgstraat (Schouwburgstraat 2). Sessions may also take place at location Wijnhaven (Turfmarkt 99), both within walking distance in the city centre.
