Content of the Programme

Terrorism, extremism and political violence remain among the most pressing security challenges of the 21st century. The Terrorism and Political Violence specialisation provides students with a research-led understanding of the causes, dynamics and consequences of extremist thinking, terrorism and political violence in a rapidly changing threat landscape. Students explore both violent and non-violent forms of extremism, including protest movements, conspiracy-driven radicalisation and terrorist activity. The programme combines theoretical perspectives with empirical research to examine when and why individuals radicalise, why some become involved in terrorism while others do not, and how processes of disengagement and deradicalisation can be fostered. Attention is paid to a broad range of contemporary threats, including jihadist terrorism, right-wing and anti-government extremism, and state-directed political violence.

Whether you are interested in the causes of political violence or in developing effective responses to it, this specialisation equips you with the analytical skills and academic foundations required for careers in security research, policy development and related professional fields.
