Research context

Fortuna plays a key role in student life at LUC. Structural changes have been implemented to improve the function of the Fortuna board. With the motto of “*One association, two boards*”, it is important to examine the institutional change Fortuna has/will be going through. The research clinic aims to assess the revised structure in terms of decision making, policy implementation and impacts.

Students' tasks and activities

Students will measure baseline effectiveness (or lack thereof) of Fortuna, hypothesize how changes should impact effectiveness, and document progress (or lack thereof). Measurement (both quantified and qualified) will take place via individual interviews, focus groups, and surveys. Documents will be analyzed to understand how promises and procedures work in reality.

Students will meet regularly with the supervisor to plan, check progress and summarize results.
