Research context

I am looking for two students to assist with researching content and contributing to the design of our Development Project Management SPOC video series. The videos to be designed and produced fall into a three-part series.

Part 1: Questions in development, include videos that cover the following topics: a) What is development? b) Who does development? c) What is a systems approach?

Part 2: Skills in development, include videos that cover the following skills: a) group work, b) systematic literature reviews, and c) research briefs

Part 3: Best and worst practices in development, include case study videos of successful and unsuccessful development efforts.

Students' tasks and activities
