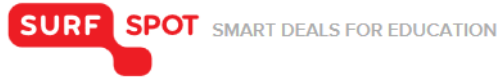



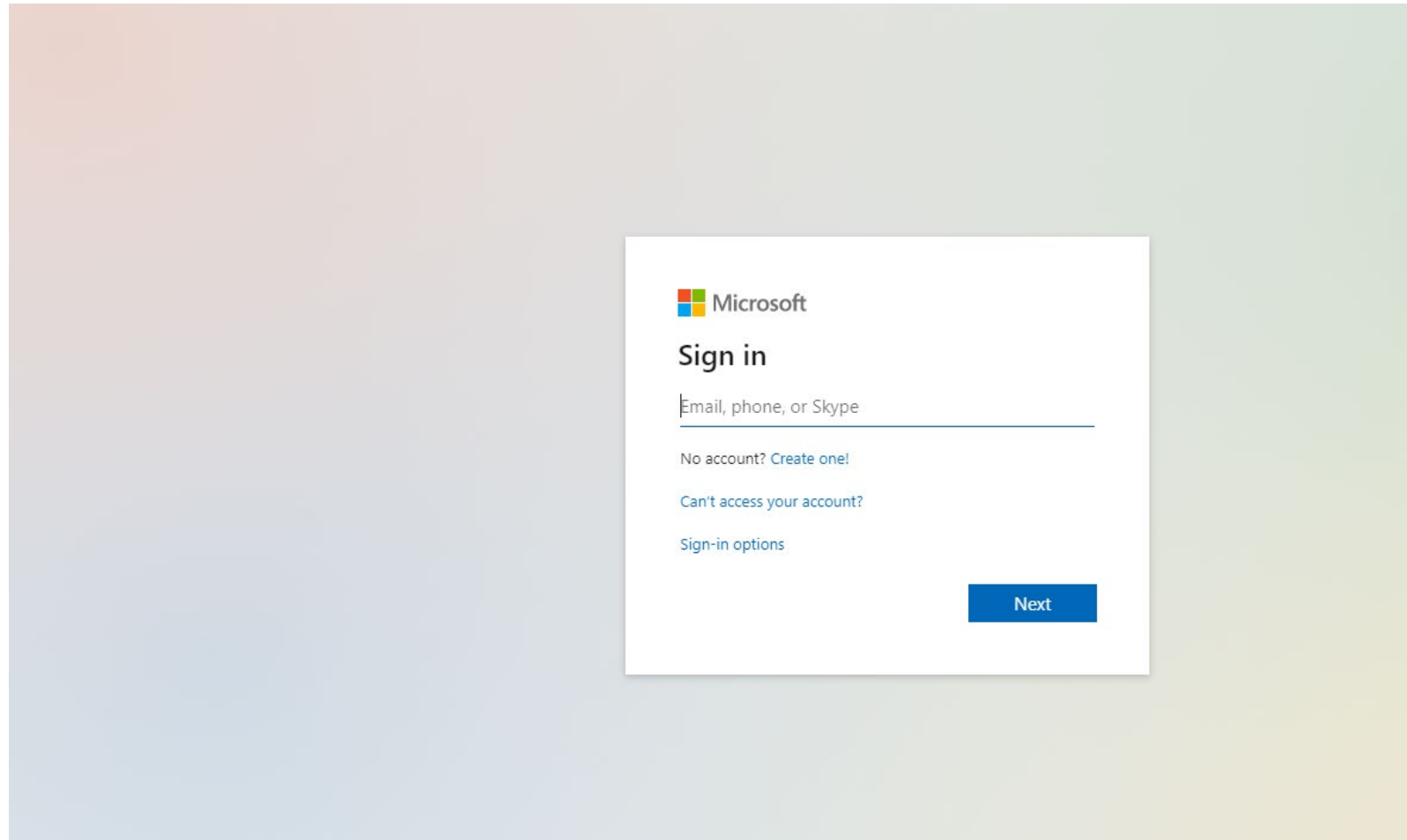

MS Teams

- Students sign in with their ULCNstudentnumber@vuw.leidenuniv.nl and the regular password
- Everyone can install Office 365 ProPlus for free on five personal Windows and Mac computers, with the complete version of Word, Powerpoint, Excel en OneNote.
 - The download is available via the Office portal .
 - TIP: If your personal device contains an older version of Office, you should remove this version before you install Office ProPlus from the university.

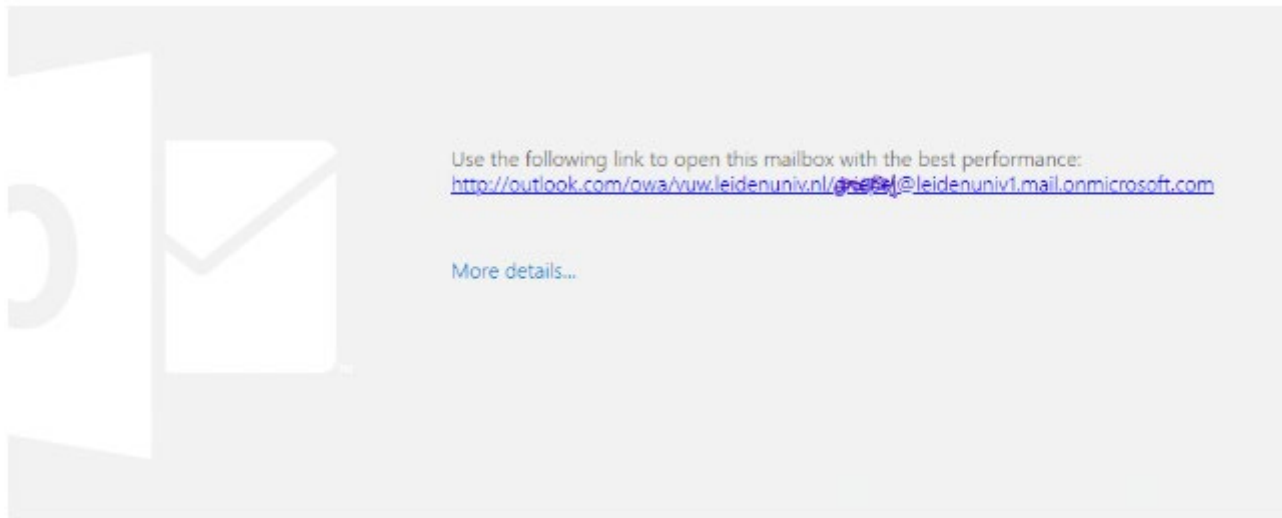

uMail

- Students and alumni can forward their uMail to any forward address that they wish. Until October 2020, all uMail mailboxes from students are gradually converted to Office 365 for better integration with other Office 365 applications and Brightspace.
- Go to <https://webmail.campus.leidenuniv.nl>
- If your uMail page appears immediately after signing in, then your uMail mailbox is not converted to Office 365 yet. In this case, the set up of a forward address is explained in the attached pdf-manual.
- If you see the screen below, then you have Office 360



Forward email

1. Click the link and sign in on the Office 365 login page of the university. Use your university Microsoft account: <ULCN studentnumber>@vuw.leidenuniv.nl and your usual ULCN password. After 3 August 2020 MFA is needed for this. uMail is displayed in Outlook.
2. In Outlook, click the cog-wheel (settings) in the top right of the menu bar.
3. Type 'Forwarding' in the *Search* field. The search results are shown immediately.
4. Click the search result *Forwarding* to open the page for entering your forward address.
5. Check the *Enable forwarding* box, enter your forward address and leave the box *Keep a copy of forwarded messages* unchecked.
6. Confirm with [Save] and close the forward address page. From now on, your uMail will be forwarded to the address that you just entered.

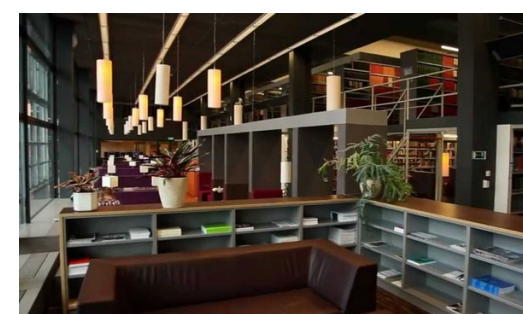


