# Insights from International Security and International Political Economy

Are you interested in geopolitical shifts in international relations? In the connections between the political, military economic domains? And how states and other actors can use various instruments to influence global affairs? Then the minor Global Affairs is for you. We will address current situations in international relations and the solutions diplomacy could, or should, provide in a continually changing environment. Lecturers with extensive in defense. diplomacy, experience international economics, organization, politics, and academia will share their knowledge on these issues as they highlight the practical side of global affairs.

## What will you learn?

You will follow a balanced package of courses in which theory and practice in this extended field of international relations are combined. We will pay attention to global trends and challenges such as: the shift of political, financial and economic power to the East and its consequences for existing international institutions; climate change; the new role of media in global events; scarcity of energy resources and the commodity markets. The minor will address both inter-state and intra-state conflict, as well as post-conflict nation building.

This minor programme is taught in English and is aimed at students from all academic backgrounds, as long as they have a keen interest in, and are enthusiastic about, global affairs, international relations, international political economy, international security and diplomacy.
