Day-to-day news is filled with questions of how the public sector should be run. It is a constantly debated issue by politicians, citizens and administrators alike. In this minor you will learn what's at stake and how governance works.

Then register for the Minor Public Administration: Multi-Level Governance at the Institute for Public Administration of the Faculty of Governance and Global Affairs. The Institute for Public Administration has all the relevant knowledge and experience and is established in the administrative and political capital of The Netherlands: right in the centre of The Hague.



What will you learn?

In this minor you will get an insight in the functioning of governance and public administration at various levels (local, national and international), such as the Union international European and organisations. You will also become familiar with the management of (semi-) public and private organisations that carry out a variety of public tasks. We discuss subjects such privatisation, globalisation, decentralization, and the influence of Europe on national member states. Critical reflection on normative and ethical issues is also a key part of this minor.

Moreover, the minor enables students to assess and conduct proper social scientific research to critically investigate public administration and to offer solutions to current and future governance challenges.

For whom is this minor?

This minor is suitable for students with all kinds of academic backgrounds, as you can only understand the complexity of public administration by using these various insights. The minor is accessible for all students from Leiden University and has been set up in a way to allow all (third-year) students to participate. If spaces are available, students from other universities can also register. With proper motivation and the full 30 ECTS minor (including the course Research in Public Administration for those without a background in the social sciences), students can enter a master's programme of the Institute of Public Administration without following a pre-master.
