Structure

The structure of the Moot Court is as follows:

1. First written round (Oct/Nov 2018);
2. Second written round (Nov 2018-Mar 2019);
3. Oral rounds (Singapore) (Mar 2019).

Participants are required to:

- Be a last year bachelor or master student at the Leiden Law School;
- Have interest in insolvency law;
- Have excellent command of English;
- Not be licensed or have been licensed to practice law;
- Comply with all rules of the Moot;
- Actively prepare for the Moot Court and provide support in finding sponsors/grants;
