



CALL FOR PAPERS

On **Thursday the 16th of June 2022**, the Societal Benefits of Higher Education conference will take place. This conference is organised by the Faculty of Governance and Global Affairs and the Department of Economics of Leiden University. It will take place at the **The Hague Campus of Leiden University, Turfmarkt 99 in The Hague.**

On this day, academics, policy makers, policy bureaus and administrators will discuss the broad societal benefits of higher education. There will be plenary sessions and policy sessions about themes such as investment in higher education, financing, inequality, internationalisation and digitalization. Additionally, academic parallel sessions will be organized around a variety of topics.

If you wish to present your research during one of the academic sessions, we invite you to submit your paper before **May 5th 2022** via **mbho@law.leidenuniv.nl**. You can opt to submit a single paper or a full academic session. A session contains 3 papers. The scientific committee is looking for papers that are relevant to the broad importance of higher education for society. Examples of relevant topics are: the returns to (higher) education (micro and macro), financing of higher education, admission policies, study choice, study success, gender difference, higher education quality, higher education and Covid-19, and the internationalisation of higher education.

The scientific committee will make a selection based on the submissions. You will be notified whether your paper has been accepted around May 19th 2022.
