

Mr Justice Jeroen M.J. Chorus (1942) graduated at Leiden University (1966) where he also obtained the degree of doctor (1976). He worked at Edinburgh University, University College London, University of Amsterdam and Leiden University. He held the Leiden chair of Roman Law and Legal History (1986-1993). He was raised to the bench in 1977 and worked at the district court Arnhem (1977-1982) and the court of appeal Amsterdam (1982-1986 and 1992-2012), both in the private law and the criminal law divisions. His published scholarly work is mainly concerned with Civil Procedure, Roman Law (including its medieval and modern history) and Comparative Law.
