



Preparing your abstract:

Structure your abstract, using the following format in Times New Roman 12 points and according to UK-English.

ABSTRACT TITLE

Short informative title, not exceeding 2 lines and maximum of 200 characters

AFFILIATIONS

Each of the authors and their affiliations, the first one is presenting the research at the conference and is corresponding author.

ABSTRACT TEXT

Objective

Describe as accurate and clear as possible what you propose to present.

Method

Describe the target organisms, research methods, measurements, treatments and analyses you performed.

Results

When reporting on empirical research present your main findings in the abstract. No riddles or cliff-hangers. If you do not have the results yet make convincingly clear that you will have them at the time of the conference.

Conclusion

State your conclusion as clear as possible. You may reflect on your study limitations and the relevance of your results in a few words.

Abstract without title and affiliations 300 words at maximum.
