

Calendar of activities Food Citizens team: January to August 2021

This period focusses on the writing process, working towards the special issue article and the thesis draft.

The calendar includes guest seminars previously postponed or originally planned for this period, and team work days (workshopping chapters, discussing vignettes, workshopping articles for the special issue). Individual supervision sessions can be inserted according to needs so that there is a fortnightly cadence of feedback when needed.

Thesis supervision:

Please before sending drafts do spell check, read again for language/English and insert page numbers. Also, mark if we have already discussed relevant parts (vignettes etc.). Accompany a re-worked draft of previous versions of the same chapter with a brief statement, what you have aimed to achieve with this revision and what the improvements/additions consist in, so that feedback can be given on your stated goals and objectives.

Go back to the thesis outline and revise it, adding a short summary/explanation for every chapter. The summary also explains how each chapter connects with the following/previous. This way, each time you work at a specific chapter you will find yourselves creating an updated outline (with date). With successive dated versions, you keep a memory of how your outline evolves (and you can always go back to previous versions).
